

Jr. High Service Chief

In our efforts to focus not only on the jr. high program itself, but specifically on the service component, we are creating a new position, the Jr. High Service Chief (JHSC). Actually this job is geared for partner leadership.

The JHSC will have a two-fold mission: by scheduling monthly service opportunities open to all parish 7th & 8th graders, coordinating chaperones, and if needed, drivers to assist on the service days themselves.

The JHSC will contact different Social Outreach Agencies in the area to determine the feasibility of said outreach, schedule a date, and coordinate the necessary details like work description for that service project.

Next a schedule for the year or semester is created.

Finally, students are able to sign-up for a specific project. Parents (or other adults) are asked to assist on the actual day of the event.

The Parent Volunteer Coordinators might be available to assist in the recruitment of responsible adult volunteers.

Additional Notes:

Especially since this is the first year as well as due to a late start, the JHSC has a herculean task. While it is probably best to have only two main coordinators, other parents would probably offer a great deal of assistance.
