Holy Spirit.

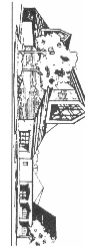

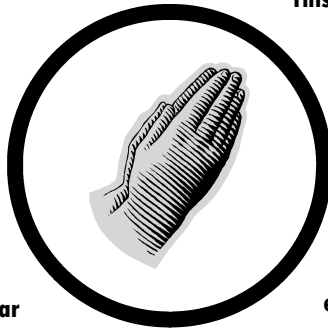
