Teen Liturgical Ministry Guru

The Teen Liturgical Ministry Guru (LMG) has a two fold mission:

First, helping either an underclassman or a new teen liturgical minister (lector or Eucharistic minister), get accustomed to the ministry schedule. This is accomplished by reminder phone calls/emails, alerting the teen to their upcoming service schedule. Suggested time frame for reminder calls/emails is Sunday or Monday prior to the upcoming weekend.

Secondly, the LMG is asked to help assist the Youth Minister in promoting and possibly attending the teen liturgical ministry trainings usually in June, occasionally in the Fall.

Additional Notes:

It is not the job of the LMG to find substitutes or contact the Liturgical Ministry Office if a teen is unable to serve on a given weekend.

It is not de facto, the job of the LMG to communicate with the Director of Liturgical Ministries. That is the responsibility of the Youth Minister.

The LMG should annually evaluate and update the teen liturgical minister roster.
