Fundraising

We will fundraise to help defray the cost of the trip. Our goal is to raise enough to cover approximately \$100.00 per person. S.A.L.T./The Mission Trip Team will sponsor a Pancake Breakfast scheduled for Sunday, May 2nd. **Please note, if we are unable to raise enough money through this fundraiser, the final cost per person will increase.** However, we do not anticipate this to be the case, yet we may have to be more creative with fundraising in general.

Registration & Deposit Deadline(s)

The OLW Mission Trip Registration Form and the non-refundable deposit of \$75.00 are required in order to reserve your spot on this trip (Checks payable to OLW). OLW has preregistered for approximately 35 teens. Once we hit this mark, we may or may not be able to obtain more spaces. Yet if we can, the deposit increases to \$90.00 for additional registrations. **We expect to fill the original 35 spaces in short order. Please register as soon as possible.**

Pre-Trip Meeting Dates

All participants are required to participate in pre-trip activities. The first gathering will be on Sunday, Jan. 17th from 7:30-9pm. These activities will be once a month and include the following components: spiritual formation, community service, fundraising, parish service, and bonding.

Parent Involvement

There will be a special parent/teen meeting on Sunday, April 18th (teens arrive at 7pm, adults at 8pm) to go over more detailed information as we get closer to the trip. Issues covered will include what to pack, free day info, paperwork such as medical release and emergency contact forms as well as time for any final questions. One parent per teen is needed for this night. The Fundraising Committee will contact parents to assist during the Pancake Breakfast Events.

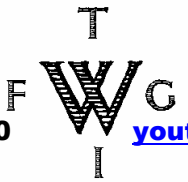
